Dear Parents and Guardians,

We hope that your summer has been going well and it has provided the opportunity for rest and relaxation. We are busy here making plans to welcome your children for the upcoming school year and want to inform you of some changes regarding the dress code for our junior high students.

Due to the new configuration of our junior high, with the 6th grade at the Jr/Sr High building, it was proposed to and accepted by the Education Council to have the junior high (grades 6-8) uniform be similar to the elementary. The dress code for the junior high will be as follows:

Boys: Khaki or navy pants, polo shirt, dress shoes.

Girls: Jumper, Skirt or Khaki or navy pants, polo shirt, dress shoes.

Jumpers/skirts: can be purchased through Tommy Hilfiger. Your own “modesty” shorts can be worn underneath. The modest shorts should not be showing below the jumper/skirt hem line. The hem line should be near the knee area, not too much above.

Shirts under jumper: White or blue shirts can be bought from any store. Preferably a peter pan collar. Can also be purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.

Polo Shirts: Navy blue, white or light blue (can be bought from any store). Both the Jr/Sr High and Elementary main offices sell the IHC emblem patch (\$3 each or 2 for \$5). You may also purchase polo shirts from the Hilfiger site with an embroidered emblem. Patches are only needed for the polo shirts.

Pants: Khaki or navy; can be bought from any store (no cargo style pants). Belts are expected when pants have belt hoops

Shorts: In the months of May, June and September only. Khaki or navy dress shorts bought from any store. No cargo style shorts.

Socks: Solid color socks/ tights with jumper and skirts. Must have feet. No footless leggings.

Shoes: Shoes should be neutral in color (brown, black, white, navy blue, or gray). Shoes must not be open-toed or open-backed. Sneaker style shoes are unacceptable. Shoes should be leather-style and not canvas. Laced Sperry’s or boat shoes are acceptable. Students will be able to change for PE. Therefore, sneakers are only for PE class.
